Caravan TV. In 2007, we began our debut episode on Queens Public Television (QPTV). Since then, we have expanded our television coverage to include community access stations within Manhattan (MNN), Brooklyn (BCAT), and the Bronx (BronxNet). In 2012, we moved to WNYC-Life channel 25 and channel 22, which further expanded our television broadcast coverage area to

include all of the five boroughs, Long Island, Westchester County, as well as parts of New Jersey and Connecticut. This was to ensure that more people could *enjoy the high caliber, educational and entertaining programming* that Cultural Caravan TV (CCPTV) offers in recognition and celebration of the culture and history of Africa and the diaspora on a weekly basis. Our guests, as well as programming, offer a refreshing alternative to mainstream media options.
